We ask and thank you for your patience, awareness, cooperation and understanding. Stalls may be limited. *Some stalls will be available on Wednesday, Sept. 17 after 10:00 a.m. We will be unable to accommodate arrivals prior to Thursday, Sept. 18 at 10:00 a.m. unless you indicate your date/time of arrival on your entry form. (Please be aware of gate/arrival hours.)*

GENERAL RULES/ALL BREEDS:

- ❖ No cross entry between classes designated for Draft Horses and Gypsy Vanner/Gypsy Horses
EXCEPTION: Classes #90 and #114 which are open to all breeds/horses. Cross entry between Gypsy Vanner (GVHS) designated classes and Gypsy Horse classes ONLY available to horses registered with and submitting a copy of GVHS papers and verification of GVHS current year membership.
- ❖ **Class # 114: "Show The Most Hair Class":** is intended to be a fun class for both the Fair-goers and all exhibitors. Open to any horse duly entered in another class at this show. No entry fee if you list this class as an entry on your entry form submitted prior to 8-15-2008. If you enter after that or at the gate, there will be \$5.00 "cash at the gate" entry fee which will go back into the class purse. One winner takes all: \$50.00 plus any additional late entry at the gate receipts! Judged on presentation and volume of designated hair. Handler to carry sign indicating which single "source of hair" their horse should be judged on: Mane; Foretop; Feather or Tail. No switches or false/added hair allowed. Stallions must be handled by adult exhibitor. Costumes welcome as long as they don't inhibit viewing of hair. Secret guest judge.
- ❖ A copy of registration papers must be submitted for all registered horses verifying breed association, gender and current and correct ownership.
- ❖ **IMPORTANT: All Exhibitors: All handlers/exhibitors/hitch or team drivers or wagons are required to be wearing or displaying their OSF provided back number(s) when entering the competition arena. Your entry will not be allowed into the show arena without this exhibitor/back number. Wearing the incorrect number may void your placing and ability to earn any prize money offered therein.**

DRAFT HORSE SHOW RULES

NORTH AMERICAN SIX HORSE HITCH CLASSIC SERIES QUALIFYING EVENT CLYDESDALE ALL AMERICAN QUALIFYING SHOW DESIGNATED: THE SOUTHERN PLAINS REGIONAL CLYDESDALE SHOW

1. The hitch classes are considered group classes. More than one owner may participate in a hitch class but only one owner should make the entry and pay the entry fee for the team. Only one driver is permitted in any of the classes. One rider is optional.
2. Stalling is assigned and stalls in Barn 6 will be limited to Draft Horse entries/farms/stables with multiple horse hitch classes ONLY. ALL stall assignments tentative pending construction completion.
3. Farm Team Classes:
 - A. Must use farm harness (no hame housings, scotch collars or patent leather).
 - B. No manes or tails braided.
 - C. Open to horses or mules.
6. Show Hitch Classes:
 - A. The same horse cannot be used in ladies' cart class #86 and men's cart class #110.
 - B. Class #82 and #108: an adult must ride with junior exhibitors.
 - C. Classes 45, 49, 52, 89, 91, 108, 115 must be fifth wheel vehicles.
 - D. Exhibitors cannot cross enter in Novice junior-men's / ladies' carts.
 - E. Novice drivers are those newer to driving and can enter this class for two years before moving up to men's / ladies' class.
7. Pleasure Classes:
 - A. #84 - Light vehicle can be 2 or 4 wheel cart, surrey, wagonette, etc., and 1 horse.
 - B. #88 - Heavy vehicle can be any larger 4 wheel wagon and a team.
 - C. Classes #84 & #88 do not require show harness, show shoes, braids and will be judged on the appearance of being a relaxing pleasure to drive.
8. Youth - is defined as a rider who is eighteen years and younger on January 1 of the calendar year of the show. Youth can show in any Jr., Sr. or Open classes.

9. Youth Decorating: CI # 56: Decorating for show is done in the ring. 30 minute time limit. Will be judged on overall neatness and degree of completion.
10. Belgian, Clydesdale, Percheron, Shire or unregistered Draft GELDINGS will compete together in appropriate gelding halter classes (i.e. Draft Horse gelding halter classes will not be split by breed).
11. No premiums (prize money) paid to Championship Halter Classes. Amount and distribution of premiums (prize money) will be based on actual number of entries entered and shown in each class. Refer to premium code after each class and premium definitions and scale following the rules for Draft Horse show/divisions.
12. Tack Stalls for single owner/farm/stable(s) entered in Draft Horse Classes: Four-Five paid horse stalls for duration of show: : One Free. Six-Seven paid horse stalls for duration of show; Two Free. Eight or More paid horse stalls for duration of show: Three Free
13. TRAVEL MONEY* FOR SIX HORSE HITCHES (Will be granted one time to each ownership entity, post show, by Oklahoma State Fair) a) Up to 250 miles: \$250.00 b) 251 to 500 miles: \$500.00 c) 500 plus miles: \$750.00 (Distance determined by city of origin of owner as listed on entries to Oklahoma City and as provided by an Internet map/direction source.) (*OSF reserves the right to partially supplement travel money with comparable value in hotel room/accommodations. Contact Horse Show Coordinator for more information prior to departure.)

GYPSY VANNER HORSE SHOW RULES (GVHS):

1. Horses MUST be registered with the Gypsy Vanner Horse Society (GVHS) and copy of registration papers (or copy of submitted registration application for current year foals) MUST be submitted with entry forms.
2. See website at www.gypsyvannerhorse.org for more detailed show, registration and membership rules.
3. REMINDER: Stallions three years and up will be required to be shown in stallion tack. Stallion tack is defined as having a bitted open bridle; side reins; surcingle; and crupper.
4. Championship Classes. Ribbons to 6 places in most classes. Except: Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes in Halter
5. No cross entering from canter to non canter class and vice versa with the same rider/horse combo.
