**RULES:**

- Youth exhibiting heifers must be members of the American-International Junior Charolais Association.
- All animals to be eligible for a Junior Charolais Heifer Class must be purebred and registered with the AICA. Only Bona Fide (original) certificates of registration will be accepted as evidence of registration and ownership: No photocopies.
- Any animal not having a legible tattoo or firebrand number is ineligible and will be barred from showing.
- All animals shown in individual classes must be weaned, with the exception of a senior yearling with a calf at side. Nurse cows are not permitted.
- All animals 20 months and older exhibited at AICA sanctioned show must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian or have produced fertile eggs as certified in a written statement by a licensed veterinarian or embryologist or have a calf at side.
- AICA requires that all animals be shown with halters.
- **Exhibitors must show in clean pressed jeans, clean shirt with collar and club emblem (4-H or FFA). 4-H and FFA jackets are acceptable but not required. T-shirts, tennis shoes, and headwear are not allowed.**
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

**PREMIUM INFORMATION:**

- Premiums will be paid in all classes except division and overall championship classes.
- Premium Scale: \$35, \$25, \$15, \$5

**ENTRY INFORMATION:**

- Owner's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Entries can be made online or mailed in. Online entries close August 15. Credit Card payments only taken online.

**FEES:**

- **Required**
  - \$25.00 per head (if postmarked or entered online by August 15)
  - \$50.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
  - \$5.00 processing fee per Division (example, if showing junior heifers, breeding swine and market sheep total would be \$15.00 in processing fees)
- **Additional**
  - Equipment permit
  - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) if postmarked by September 1, 2008. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$23.00 good for all 11 days.
  - Exhibitor will receive complimentary Exhibitor Book of 4 Gate tickets good for 4 days admission with Junior Entry.

**GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules, regulations, specifications and requirements set out in the General Rules and Regulations section (found separate from this section) and any other said rules distributed by Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) management.

**Classes:**

- Classes will be broken after arrival and check-in at the show.
- Heifers born after September 1, 2006 are eligible to show.
- There will be one bred and owned class at the conclusion of the Owned Show. To be eligible, heifers must have been exhibited in Owned Show.
