- This is an official sanctioned show of the ARBA and the Oklahoma State Fair®. It will be governed by all the rules and regulations of these associations.
- The Oklahoma State Fair® will accept the first 500 entries.
- Entry form listing number of rabbits you plan to enter including ear number and variety along with your entry fees must be postmarked no later than August 15, 2008.
- Each individual owner must be on a separate form (not 2 or 3 family members entering on the same form).
- No telephone, late or day of the show entries will be accepted.

RULES:

1. Absolutely NO rabbits allowed in the show ring unless they are entered in the competition.
2. Animals must be entered in the name of the bona fide owner.
3. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly earmarked.
4. Substitutes will be accepted in the same class and sex only.
5. Rabbits entered in the Youth Show (Division 1124) cannot be shown in the Open Show (Division 1123) and vice versa.
6. ARBA, BUOY, or the Oklahoma State Fair® will not be responsible in case of fire, theft, accident, etc.
7. Rabbits must be in leak proof cages, NO EXCEPTIONS.
8. Judges remark cards and awards must be picked up the day of the show. Premiums will be mailed.
9. Rabbits will enter the Fairgrounds via Gate 7 from Portland Avenue unload cages in West end of Barn #3, and then exit Gate 8 for parking. The show will be held in Barn #3.

PREMIUM INFORMATION:

- Ribbons will be awarded for the first five (5) places in every class, including meat pen and fur classes.
- Premium Scale: 1st - \$5, 2nd - \$4, 3rd - \$3, 4th - \$2, 5th - \$1

Special Awards will be given as follows:

- Best Rabbit of ShowBanner and Buckle
- First Reserve RabbitBanner and Buckle
- Second Reserve RabbitBanner and Buckle
- Best of BreedRosette
- Best Opposite of BreedRosette

All Other Breeds

 - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 6 - 11) if postmarked by September 1, 2008.
