**RULES:**

- The Texas Longhorn Open Division is open to cattle registered with the Texas Longhorn Breeders of America Association, 2315 N Main Street, Suite 402, Ft. Worth, TX 76106. All animals must be registered with the TLBAA and a copy of the original certificate is required for presentation before the show.
- Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) and the TLBAA. When an exhibitor signs the entry form, he/she agrees to abide with the rules and regulations established by the Oklahoma State Fair® as well as the TLBAA. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation or not abiding by the show rules will be disqualified.
- A current health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all cattle. This health certificate should state that the cattle have met all of the current Brucellosis and TB requirements for movement from their origination to the show.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to show their animal in a neat clean condition. Washing, brushing, combing and trimming of excess hair are permitted. Specifically prohibited are the clipping of hair other than at the prepuce of bulls on the premises of show locations, the sanding and polishing of horns, polishing of hooves sheen or sparkle additives to the hair.
- Violation of these rules will be grounds for removal from competition by show management and forfeiture of all fees.
- Sprays or concentrates specifically formulated and sold as fly and/or insect inhibitor or prohibiters are allowed to be applied to the hair.
- All bulls are required to be shown with a nose lead.
- When questions arise concerning items not covered by these rules, the show committee will make the decision concerning the point in question and the decision of this committee will be binding.

- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

**PREMIUM INFORMATION:**

- The Oklahoma Texas Longhorn Association will sponsor 50% of the premiums.
- Premiums will be paid to exhibitors directly by the Oklahoma State Fair®.
- Premiums will be paid in all classes except division and overall championship classes.
- Individual Class Premiums: \$50, \$30, \$20, \$10, \$5
- Group Class Premiums: \$40, \$30, \$20

**ENTRY INFORMATION:**

- Owner's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Substitutions can be made on existing entries for \$10.00 per sub and must be made in the Livestock Show Office by 4:00 PM the day before the show.

**FEES:****Required**

- \$25.00 per head (if postmarked or entered online by August 15)
- \$50.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
- \$75.00 per head (if postmarked after September 1 & by 4:00 PM the day before the show)
- \$5.00 per head (TLBAA for the World Expo)
- \$25.00/per head (Oklahoma Texas Longhorn Breeders)
- \$5.00 processing fee/per owner
- \$20.00 Exhibitor Admission Pack (2 Books of 4 Tickets, good for only 2 individuals for up to 4 days)

- Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) if postmarked by September 1, 2009. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$23.00 good for all 11 days.
