RULES:

- Any member in good standing of the Texas Longhorn Breeders of Tomorrow (TLBT) or an Active or Lifetime member of the TLBAA may show in TLBT Youth Shows as long as the exhibitor of the animals is 18 years old or younger as of January 1. Anyone 17 years old or younger may become a member of the TLBT by paying annual dues.
- Calves must be registered with the TLBAA. However, they are not required to be registered in the name of the youth. A copy of registration must accompany all entry forms for verification of age and registration.
- Texas Longhorn Breeders of Tomorrow shows are considered Open Show. Cattle may be owned by the youth, ranch or other breeders of Texas Longhorn Cattle.
- A current health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all cattle. This health certificate should state that the cattle have met all of the current Brucellosis and TB requirements for movement from their origination to the show.
- Nose leads with strap (not tongs) will be used on all bulls.
- A dress code will be enforced at this show. The dress code will be Western attire: Long sleeve shirt with collar and cuffs. Western boots and western jeans are to be worn while in the ring. Western hats, not caps, may be worn. Violators of this rule will be disqualified upon the discretion of the show committee.
- No parents of the exhibitors will be allowed in the show arena except in the case of an emergency, or in the six-year-old and under Peewee class.
- When questions arise concerning items not covered by these rules, the Show Committee for the respective show will make the decision concerning the point in question and its decision will be binding.

- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

PREMIUM INFORMATION:

- Ribbons furnished by Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) and championship awards by OTLA for Youth Classes, no premium monies will be paid.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Owner's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Substitutions can be made on existing entries for \$10.00 per sub and must be made in the Livestock Show Office by 4:00 PM the day before the show.

FEES:

- **Required**
 - \$25.00 per head (if postmarked or entered online by August 15)
 - \$50.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
 - \$75.00 per head (if postmarked after September 1 & by 4:00 PM the day before the show)

- \$5.00 per head (TLBAA for the World Expo)
- \$5.00 processing fee/per owner
- \$20.00 Exhibitor Admission Pack (2 Books of 4 Tickets, good for only 2 individuals for up to 4 days)
- **Additional**
 - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) if postmarked by September 1, 2009. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$23.00 good for all 11 days.
