RULES:

- The Governor's trophy will be awarded to the owner of the Oklahoma Dairy Cow with the highest production (All breeds competing). Certificates given to all winners/participants.
- Awards will be based on their production record only, computed to a 305-day mature equivalent, converted to energy corrected milk.
- The records must be presented on a DHIA 203 Form started and completed in Oklahoma.
- The cow must be owned by an Oklahoma Exhibitor, entered and shown in her respective junior or open class at the 2009 Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF).
- **Owners must have in hand a DHIA 200, 220 or monthly report;** DHIA 103, 203 or breed Lactation Certificate to the show officials by 2:00 PM, Monday, September 21. Limit two entries per exhibitor.
- All animals entered in this class must be brought to the show ring and paraded at the award ceremony on Tuesday, September 22, at the conclusion of the Dairy Show.
- Current lactation 305 ME records will be used for cows greater than 305 days in milk at the time of the most recent test date. For cows less than 305 days in milk in the current lactation, the previous lactation record will be used.
