RULES:

- Heifers may be entered in the open show by paying entry fees and buying an Exhibitors Admission Pack.
- All animals shown must be 75% or higher Limousin (NALF percentage) with orange registration papers or registered Limflex with purple registration papers in the name of the junior exhibitor to be eligible to show.
- All animals must be registered with the North American Limousin Foundation by show date.
- Registration papers must show that the heifer was owned or transferred to the exhibitor prior to July 1 of the current year. All exhibitors must have registration papers in their own name.
- Percentage, purebred and Limflex cattle shall compete in the same classes and championships.
- Registration papers from the Breed Association that are in order are acceptable. Copies, telegrams, or phone calls are not acceptable.
- Check tattoos and registration papers before arriving at the show.
- **Exhibitors must show in clean pressed jeans, clean shirt with collar and club emblem (4-H or FFA). 4-H and FFA jackets are acceptable but not required. T-shirts, tennis shoes, and headwear are not allowed.**
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

PREMIUM INFORMATION:

- Premiums will be paid in all classes except division and overall championship classes.
- Premium Scale: \$35, \$25, \$15, \$5

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Owner's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Entries can be made online or mailed in. Online entries close August 15. Credit Card payments only taken online.

FEES:

- **Required**
 - \$25.00 per head (if postmarked or entered online by August 15)
 - \$50.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
 - \$5.00 processing fee per Division (example, if showing junior heifers, breeding swine and market sheep total would be \$15.00 in processing fees)
- **Additional**
 - Equipment permit
 - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) if postmarked by September 1, 2009. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$23.00 good for all 11 days.
 - Exhibitor will receive complimentary Exhibitor Book of 4 Gate tickets good for 4 days with Junior Entry.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules, regulations, specifications and requirements set out in the General Rules and Regulations section (found separate from this section) and any other said rules distributed by OSF management.

Classes:

- Classes will be broken after arrival and check-in at the show.
- Heifers born after September 1, 2007 are eligible to show.
- There will be one bred and owned class at the conclusion of the Owned Show. To be eligible, heifers must have been exhibited in Owned Show.
