Deadline to receive ENTRY FORMS is August 15, 2009.

Exhibits being entered for competition will be received during the weekend prior to the start of the Fair. Bring entries to the Creative Arts Building at the following times:

Saturday, September 12	10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Sunday, September 13	12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m.

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 13.

Space permitting, all articles entered for competition will be retained and displayed for the entire duration of the 2009 Oklahoma State Fair. No articles will be released until after September 27.

Claim checks must be presented to retrieve exhibits. Articles will be released from the Creative Arts Building at the following times:

Monday, September 28	1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Tuesday, September 29	9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The following will not be accepted for exhibit or competition in this department:

- Clothing that has been worn or soiled**
- Linens that are aged, used or soiled**
- Knitted or crocheted bedspreads**
- Wedding dresses**
- Textile Painting**
- Yo Yo Spreads**

All entries in this department must be textiles that have been sewn, hand-woven, knitted or crocheted. Must have been completed since October 1, 2008.

Articles may not be entered in unspecified classes by an exhibitor who has already placed like article in the same class.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SECTION 1 – Entry Requirements

Entries are limited to bona fide residents of Oklahoma. No entry fee is required unless listed. Entries must be made by individuals **ONLY** unless specifically excepted.

PROFESSIONALS are considered to be persons receiving a major part or all of their income from their craft, including teaching and/or instructing of same. PROFESSIONALS are not eligible, except as noted at the beginning of a section.

Entry deadline for all departments is AUGUST 15. You may download entry forms or enter online from our Web site: www.okstatefair.com.

Exhibitors may make only one entry in each class unless otherwise stated.

No additions to entry forms will be accepted after the August 15 deadline.

All entry forms must be COMPLETELY filled out, or they will not be accepted.

Give a short description of the article entered in all miscellaneous classes or special classes.

Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor except in the classes for Antiques and Collections. Antiques and Collections must be the bona fide property of exhibitor. Articles that have been entered at a previous Oklahoma State Fair are not eligible for entry, except as noted. All entries must be clean, and the metal must be polished and in good condition for display.

Should any article be entered in the wrong class, the superintendent may make proper correction in the entry, except as noted.

SECTION 2 - Exhibitor Duties and Privileges

If it is ascertained that an exhibitor has made any false statement in regard to any article or exhibit, or, if any exhibitor shall attempt to harass or interfere with the judge or judges in the performance of their duties, the exhibitor shall be excluded from competition and forfeit all premiums.

Exhibits in all departments — EXCEPT specific divisions of the Cooking Department — will be released from 1 PM to 5 PM, Monday, September 28, and 9 AM to 3 PM, Tuesday, September 29. No exhibits will be released early. If you have entries in the Cooking Department, check each division for pickup time. No exhibit will be released without presentation of claim check.

Every effort will be made to display entries in an attractive arrangement; however, items entered for competition will be displayed only through 3rd place. Other entries will be displayed only as space is available and at the discretion of the superintendents. The Oklahoma State Fair® reserves the right to reject any exhibit offered if it is objectionable in any way, if it requires an excessive amount of space, or if the capacity of the department has been reached.

An Exhibitor may pick up a friend's articles by presenting claim check.

Any contest may be cancelled for lack of entries.

THE STATE FAIR IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR AND WILL DISPOSE OF ANY ARTICLES OR EXHIBITS LEFT AFTER 3:00 PM, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 29.

Your items will be handled with care; however, Oklahoma State Fair, Inc. is not responsible for items that get damaged while on display during the Fair.

Any protest must be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$50, which will be forfeited if protest is not sustained. Said protest must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal and must be filed with the Manager by Noon on Thursday, opening day of the Fair.

SECTION 3 - Awards

All cash prizes will be paid from the awards as marked by the judges and not from ribbons that may be attached to the exhibits. Judges are instructed not to award cash prizes or ribbons unless article or articles are deemed worthy of the placing awarded.

BEST OF SHOW payouts for the Creative Arts Department WILL be mailed to exhibitor after the close of the Fair.

Within 90 days from the last day of the 2009 Oklahoma State Fair, it is the responsibility of the Payee to file, in writing, a claim for lost or incorrect awards.

- ◆ All articles must be handwoven, having warp and weft thread structure.
- ◆ No more than two entries per category will be accepted from each exhibitor. (Limit 22 entries per exhibitor).
- ◆ All weaving exhibits will be judged by the following score:

Color and Design:	40%
Competency of weaving:	40%
Suitability:	20%
- ◆ Entries scoring less than 80% will be placed on exhibition only at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- ◆ Piece goods exhibited must consist of at least 2 yards.
- ◆ Finished articles will not be accepted if piece goods from which it was made have already been judged at a previous Oklahoma State Fair.
- ◆ Open to everyone, amateur and professional.
