**NEW IN 2010:** Exhibitors armbands for complete entries submitted no later than 9-1-2010, which:

- a) Will be picked up at Gate 7 upon arrival after start of Fair with Exhibitor's parking passes, etc.
- b) Will allow bearer free admission through Gate 7 only for period of time designated on the armband.
- c) Must be on exhibitor's wrist and cannot be transferred.
- d) Cannot be purchased and lost or destroyed armbands cannot be replaced.
- e) Will be allotted:
  - 1-2 horses entered: 1 armband
  - 3-4 horses entered: 2 armbands
  - 5+ horses entered: 3 armbands (maximum)

### **GENERAL RULES/ALL BREEDS:**

- ❖ **NO revision, disassembly or dismantling of stalls.** Refer to General Rules for rules/policy regarding disassembly of stalls.
- ❖ No cross entry between classes designated for Draft Horses and Gypsy horses. EXCEPTION: Class #'s 097, 098, 099, 102 which are open to all breeds/horses. EXCEPTION: Class #'s 084, 105 & 107: Open to Draft and Drum Horses (no Gypsy horses)
- ❖ A copy of registration papers must be submitted for all registered horses verifying breed association, age, gender and current and correct ownership.
- ❖ **IMPORTANT: All Exhibitors: All handlers/exhibitors/hitch or team drivers or wagons are required to be wearing or displaying OSF provided back number(s) when entering the competition arena. Entries will not be allowed into the show arena without this exhibitor/back number. Not wearing or displaying the correct number may void exhibitor placing and ability to earn any prize money offered therein.**
- ❖ Tack Stalls for single owner/farm/stable(s) entered (cannot be shared by more than one owner, stable or farm): Four-Five paid horse stalls for duration of show=One Free tack stall; Six-Seven paid horse stalls for duration of show=Two Free tack stalls; Eight or More paid horse stalls for duration of show=Three Free tack stalls. (**OSF will allot and assign these as entries are made.**)
- ❖ Ribbons to 6 places in most classes. Exception: Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes only in Championship Halter classes
- ❖ Lunch or other breaks at discretion of officials/show management and will be announced.

### **SHIRE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW INFORMATION**

#### **ASHA Premier Points Program:**

1. Points for year end Premier awards will be given in all Shire halter classes EXCEPT those marked NP. For information on the points program, visit [www.shirehorse.org](http://www.shirehorse.org) and click on "Shows" in the menu, then click on "ASHA Point System".

#### **ASHA Show Eligibility Rules**

- A. Shire stallions, mares, and geldings registered with the American Shire Horse Association, the Canadian Shire Horse Association or the Shire Horse Society are eligible to show in registered classes. "Notified Colts" that are parentage verified and recorded in the name of the exhibitor are eligible to show.
- B. Foals must be registered.
- C. Horses must be entered by the owner(s) listed on the horse's registration paper. Show entry forms usually list this as 'exhibitor' or 'entrant'. Persons acting as agent or handler for the horse being shown may not be listed as the exhibitor/entrant. The owner does not have to be the person showing the horse. Leased horses may be entered by the leaser as recorded by the respective associations.

- D. Mares registered as 3/4 and 7/8 Shire may be shown with full registered mares. Geldings registered as 3/4, 7/8 or 15/16 Shire may be shown with full registered geldings
- E. Geldings must be registered with a recognized Shire registry to be eligible for championships, best of breed or supreme champion titles, as well as premier points. Registered geldings must also be parentage verified in order to qualify for premier points.
- F. Geldings that are not registered must be of Shire type to show in a grade gelding class.
- G. When a horse registered with SHS or CHSA (but not with ASHA) is entered, a copy of the registration paper must be sent to the ASHA Secretary in order to allow verification of eligibility.
- H. All horses shown in group classes must be registered (get, produce, mare and foal, herd).
- I. Copies of registration papers, showing the exhibitor as owner, must be presented to the ASHA Show coordinator for ALL late or post entered horses before they may be shown.
- J. Any horse found to be ineligible to show after the judging will forfeit all awards and premium money.

#### **Best American Bred Shire Classes**

To be eligible, horses must be born and raised in the United States and must be registered with the ASHA. Horses may be of any age and must be entered and shown in an individual halter class.

#### **Best American Bred and Owned**

To be eligible, horses must be born and raised in the United States and bred by owner. Horse must also be registered with the ASHA. Horses may be of any age and must be entered and shown in an individual halter class.

#### **Futurity Classic**

To be eligible, horses must be entered and verified by the Futurity Classic Secretary and ASHA show coordinator. Horse must also be registered with the ASHA. All horses entered will be judged while in their respective age/gender halter classes. The top two from each gender/age class will compete for the Supreme title for their age group.

### **DRAFT HORSE CLASS SHOW RULES**

1. The hitch classes are considered group classes. More than one owner may participate in a hitch class but only one owner should make the entry and pay the entry fee for the team. Only one driver is permitted in any of the classes. One rider/passenger is optional.
2. **Farm Team Classes:**
  - A. Must use farm harness (no hame housings, scotch collars or patent leather).
  - B. Shoes are optional.
  - C. Team can use a forecart or any larger 4 wheel wagon and a team of 2 (two) horses.
  - D. No manes or tails braided.
  - E. Open to horses or mules.
3. **Show Hitch and Cart Classes:**
  - A. Traditional Draft Horse show harness is required. (Scotch collars, patent leather, biothane, etc.)
  - B. The same horse cannot be used in ladies' cart class #130 and men's cart class #137.
  - C. Class #129 and #133: an adult must ride with junior exhibitors.
  - D. Classes 074, 076, 088, 091, 095, 114, 133, 135, 139 & 141 must be fifth wheel vehicles.
  - E. Exhibitors cannot cross enter in Novice, Youth and/or Men's / Ladies' carts.
  - F. Novice drivers are those newer to driving and can enter this class for two years before moving up to Men's /Ladies' class.
4. **Pleasure Classes:**
  - A. #110 - Light vehicle can be 2 or 4 wheel cart, surrey, wagonette, etc., pulled by 1 or 2 horses.
  - B. #112 - Heavy vehicle can be any larger 4 wheel wagon and a team.
  - C. The same vehicle (wagon, cart, etc.) cannot be used in both classes: 110 & 112.
  - D. Classes #110 & #112 do not require show harness, show shoes, and/or braids and will be judged on the appearance of being a relaxing pleasure to drive.

5. Youth - is defined as a rider /driver who is eighteen years and younger on January 1 of the calendar year of the show. Youth can show in any Jr., Sr. or Open classes EXCEPT for cart classes.
6. Youth Decorating: Class # 116: Decorating for show is done in the ring. 30 minute time limit. Will be judged on overall neatness and degree of completion.
7. Belgian, Clydesdale, Percheron or unregistered Draft GELDINGS will compete together in appropriate gelding halter classes (i.e. Draft Horse gelding halter classes will not be split by breed: Exception: Registered Shire Gelding classes. Cannot cross enter multiple gelding halter classes.
8. No premiums (prize money) paid by Oklahoma State Fair to Futurity, Championship or Supreme Halter Classes. Amount and distribution of premiums (prize money) will be based on actual number of entries entered, shown and judged in each class. Refer to premium code after each class and premium definitions and scale following the rules for Draft Horse show/divisions. The premiums/prize money to entries in a single horse/hitch unit class will only be paid the actual class entry fee for each class so entered. (Exclusive of any late fees.)
9. TRAVEL MONEY FOR SIX HORSE HITCHES (Will be granted one time to each ownership entity, post show, by Oklahoma State Fair) a) Up to 250 miles: \$250.00 b) 251 to 500 miles: \$500.00; 500 plus miles: \$750.00 (Distance determined by city of origin of horses and/or owners as listed on entries to Oklahoma City and as provided by an Internet map/direction source.)

### **PREMIUM CODE DEFINITIONS AND PAYOUT SCALE FOR DRAFT/SHIRE HORSE CLASSES EXCLUDING FUTURITY, CHAMPIONSHIP OR SUPREME HALTER CLASSES:**

\*ALL classes with one/single entry (horse and/or hitch) will be eligible for the class entry fee (only) being paid, exclusive of any late entry fees that may have been paid, regardless of applied Premium Code.

\*Classes with three (3) or less entries (entered AND shown) will be eligible for 50% of applied premiums:

\*The Premium Code will be designated by a letter in ( ) after each applicable class unless otherwise noted.

\*Classes NOT designated with a Premium Code will follow the OSF Prize Money Scale as provided in the General Rules.

### **GYPSY HORSE/DRUM HORSE SHOW RULES**

**Gypsy and Drum horse classes will be paid prize money in accordance with the OSF Prize Money Scale as noted in the OSF General Rules for other OSF Horse Shows unless otherwise noted herein.**

1. All horses entered in any class designated for Gypsy horses must be considered a full blood Gypsy horse and registered as a purebred Gypsy within at least one of the following registries/associations and provide a current legible copy of the registration certificate with show entries verifying registration status, age, gender and current ownership:
  - a) Gypsy Vanner Horse Society (hereinafter referred to as GVHS)
  - b) Gypsy Cob and Drum Horse Association
  - c) Gypsy Horse Registry of America (fka Gypsy Cob Society)
  - d) Gypsy Horse Association
2. Gypsy Classes will be held following joint effort rules that are available at: <http://www.vanners.org/wp-content/uploads/2010/01/Show-Rules-2010.pdf>
4. No cross entering from canter to non canter class and vice versa with the same rider/horse combination.
5. No cross entering between Draft/Gypsy/Drum classes with the following exceptions:

- a) Classes designated Open/Farm (#097, 098, 099 and 102) and Ride A Draft classes (# 84, 105, 107.): Open to Drum and Draft Horses (No Gypsy entries)
- b) Horses entered in Drum Horse Halter Classes (#81 or #82) must be registered as a Drum horse with either the GCDHA or ADHA. Copies of registration papers verifying registry status and current ownership must be submitted with entries. No Youth handlers in Class # 82.
- c) **Liberty Class # 096:**
  - I. This is intended to be a fun class showing the natural beauty, elegance and animation of the Gypsy and/or Drum horse and is not considered breed association sanctioned or approved. Placings will be determined by the Judge and the Judge may request assistance from the audience.
  - II. Owner to provide a CD with their selection of music inclusive of designation as to which track, owner's name and horse's name and back #. Must be provided at the start of the session including class # 96 (Friday morning).
  - III. Handler/exhibitor with back number brings the single/entered horse into the arena and will release the horse at the start of the music. Judging and timing starts when the horse is released. There will be 1 ½ minutes of "liberty", during which time, handler and one assistant, if desired, can be in the arena with the horse to encourage safe movement and action of the horse. Whips and shaker bottles are permitted but touching the horse in any way during the "performance" will result in disqualification.
  - IV. After 1 ½ minutes, the music will be stopped and the handler and assistant will be required to immediately catch the horse within the next two minutes. Failure to catch the horse within the next two minutes will result in disqualification.
  - V. Exhibitor/handler and assistant must be properly attired.
