RULES:

- Alfalfa exhibits must have been produced in the state of Oklahoma during the year 2010. Any producer is eligible to enter one exhibit in each of two classes.
Three (3) bales will constitute an entry. Entries will be made at the County Extension Center. A composite sample for analysis must be submitted through the County Extension Office to:

- All entries will be judged as individual exhibits. However, entries may be submitted as a group by a county or local hay association (e.g. X exhibits for X County) before the names of the individual exhibitors are known. This is to accommodate those hay shows, which take place after the entry deadline of August 15. Check with your local OSU County Extension Center to determine if this procedure will be followed in your county. Exhibitors do not have to compete in a county hay show to exhibit in the Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) Alfalfa Hay Show.
The Alfalfa Hay Show superintendent must receive a composite sample from three (3) bales to be entered no later than Friday, August 28, 2010. Sample bags, instructions for sampling and a sampling probe are available at each Oklahoma State University Extension Center. This sampling probe should be used to obtain a valid, representative sample under the direction of the County Extension Director. These samples will be used for the protein analysis and must be submitted by the local OSU County Extension Center.
Factors considered by the judges include protein, maturity, texture, leafiness, and freedom from foreign material, color, size and shape of bales, odor and freedom from mold.
In lieu of an entry fee, all hay will become the property of the Oklahoma State Fair® to cover the cost of analysis.

ENTRY INFORMATION:
